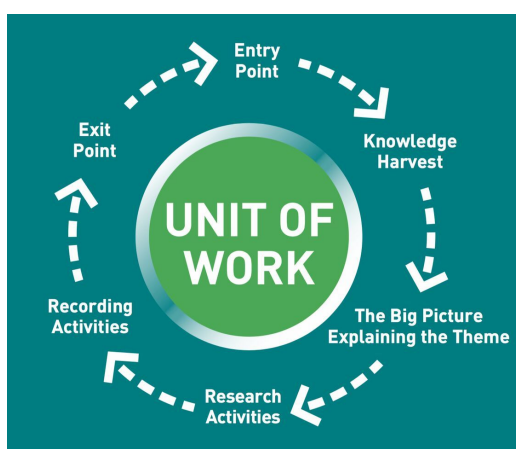


What is the IPC?

The International Primary Curriculum is a curriculum that is being used in over 1800 schools in over 90 countries around the world. It was launched in 2000 having been created by a team of leading experts in children's learning from around the world.

Each unit is structured to make sure that children's learning experiences are as stimulating as possible. The units provide practical advice to teachers who are able to differentiate instruction and outcome as needed. All the units follow the same process of learning as described below.



This process is based upon research and is designed to ensure that students are learning the way their brain is meant to learn best.

At Futuraskolan International School of Stockholm, we utilize the IPC curriculum in Grades 1 - 5. Each year, each grade explores 6 comprehensive units that provide learning, personal, and international goals in variety of subjects; history, geography, science, ICT, technology, music, PE, art, and more. Brainwaves, a unit that discusses our brain and the gaining of knowledge, skills and understanding and allows students to find out more about how we learn, and how we can improve our learning, is the lead unit for each Grade level annually. Futuraskolan follows the natural progression in curriculum development by using IMYC (International Middle Years Curriculum) during middle school years.
